Flowers on Sanctuary Altar

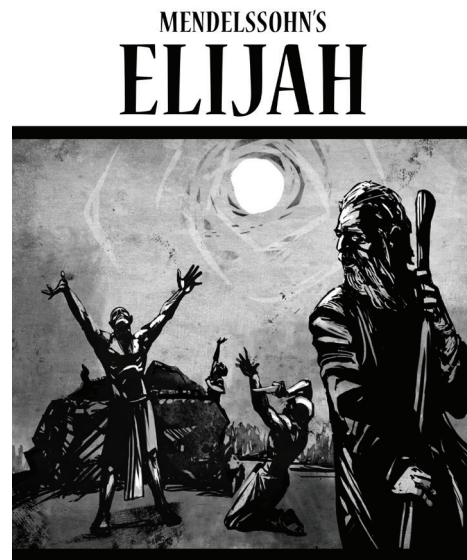
